Who *are we?*

Angel Flight Northeast is a non-profit organization that provides free flights in private aircraft by volunteer pilots, for persons who need to access medical care or have other compelling needs. Angel Flight NE brings hope and compassion to what can be a difficult time in a person's life.

There is never a charge for an Angel Flight.

Who do *we fly?*

Angel Flights are available to anyone – children, adults, and family members – whose financial resources do not permit them to travel by commercial airlines to get medical diagnosis or treatment. We also fly those who are unable to travel by car because of their medical condition, or when public transportation would cause further hardship. Angel Flight NE can also help those who live in remote areas where suitable transportation is not available.



Patients must be medically stable and ambulatory, and able to board aircraft with little or no assistance. Patients with oxygen and wheelchair requirements should bring someone with them for support. Flights are provided as often as necessary to meet people's medical needs.



Humanitarian *flights*

We also fly persons who need to visit critically ill or injured family members or those who are hospitalized for a long time, as well as the terminally ill, people needing organ transplants, organ donations, or any other time-critical need. Angel Flight NE also flies children to medical camps.

Where do *we fly?*

Through our membership in Air Care Alliance, and our airline partners and corporate aircraft we can provide flights throughout most of the country and Canada. Angel Flight Northeast flies extensively in the Northeast portion of the country. We can operate from small remote landing strips to large metropolitan airports.
